Simple Steps for your vet to set up a Kansas State Rabies Diagnostic Account and make Titer Testing affordable!

- 1. Go to the website www.ksvdl.org
- 2. There are (4) pictures in the middle of the screen, click on the one titled, "Submission Forms"
- 3. Look to the right on the screen that pops up and click on "Client Registration Form".
- 4. Fill out your clinic/hospitals information and click "Submit"
- 5. You will receive an email with your Diagnostic Lab Code.

Once you have this code you the Veterinary Clinic/Hospital are ready to submit samples.

- 1. Go to www.ksvdl.org
- 2. Click on the third picture that says, "Submission Forms".
- 3. Scroll down towards the bottom and find "Core-Vaccine Titer Submission Form.
- 4. Under that heading there are two items, click on Core Vaccine Titer Online Only
- 5. "Core Vaccine Titer Submission Form" pops up as the next screen.
- 6. Enter your "Client Account Number" which starts with the letter D plus some numbers.
- 7. Hit enter and all your clinic/hospital information pops up.
- 8. At the bottom it says Patient Details, here you put your client's information and the pets.
- 9. You can put in several clients and pets under one submission form. Hit the "Submit" tab.
- 10. You, the veterinary clinic/hospital will immediately receive (2) emails, one with the submission form and a second email with a free UPS label.

11. Print the submission form, put it in a box or bubble wrapped lined envelope with the sample(s) and place the UPS label on. Give it to the UPS driver, a UPS mail drop or a UPS center. No refrigeration needed, results will come to the Vet clinic/hospital by e mail in 2 weeks.

12. You can simply forward the results to the owner.

13. The fee for the modified Rabies RFFIT test is \$33. For the core vaccine test which includes rabies, distemper, parvo and Adenovirus its \$55.50. An endpoint Screen (not for travel is \$120. It is not yet on the online system.

14. Add a reasonable markup fee to make a reasonable profit.

Instructions for Preparing Sample: Draw 2-3 cc's of whole blood and spin in a serum separator tube for 10 minutes. Leave it in the serum separator tube.
